**Organizational Purposes:**

The purpose of the Chapters of TRANSPORTATION ENERGY PARTNERSHIP is to educate people, corporations, agencies and others about problems related to pollution, environmental hazards, and health risks of the current transportation sector, and solutions related to the use of clean burning fuels in vehicles. The use of natural gas, electric, ethanol, propane, solar, hydrogen and other clean means of propulsion a helps to produce a cleaner environment for the cities, suburban, and rural areas of the United States, helps to minimize our national need for and dependence on imported oil, and increases the health and welfare of people adversely affected by air pollution.

**Organizational Activities:**

The organization plans to conduct educational activities about the environmental and health benefits of reducing pollution through decreased use of fossil fuels, by working to:

- Educate the general public about issues concerning local pollution, the risks posed by it, and the effect on the healthy and full development of children and adults
- Conduct educational programs, provide information, and collect literature and materials about issues related to environmental pollution, air pollution, and their negative health effects.
- Collect and report information about the environment and any pollution problems and then disseminate that information to and all interested segments of the general population.
- Create educational materials about the pollution caused by polluting fuels relative to the performance and effect of alternative fuel vehicles that use electric, natural gas, ethanol, propane, solar and other means of energy for propulsion.
- Establishing networks and exchanging information with individuals and organizations about available resources to promote better understanding of pollution and environmental issues concerning the use of polluting fuels as compared to alternative fuel vehicles.

As with the Central Organization, the sources of income for the organization include individual contributions, corporate donations, foundation grants, and income from any research, information, or seminars that are made available to the public at a fee not to exceed the cost to the organization of obtaining and producing such information.

As with the Central Organization, the expenditures of the organization will be for efforts to research, collect, and disseminate to all interested people within the general public, information about the health and environmental issues related to air pollution caused by the use polluting fuels in transportation.
